Now Taking Applications for Spring 2020

Admission Requirements & Procedure:

1. Applications to the Langston Nursing Program are accepted until Oct 1, 2019.
2. Classes start January 2020. It is a 4-semester (2-year) program. The class starting Jan. 2020 will graduate Dec. of 2021 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) and therefore be eligible to take the NCLEX exam to become a Registered Nurse (RN).
3. **Requirements to be considered for admission to the nursing program are:**
 - completion of prerequisite courses listed on the Plan of Study with a grade of “C” or higher in each course.
 - no more than 2 prerequisite courses may have been repeated to earn a “C”
 - GPA of 2.7 or higher
 - ACT score of 15 or higher is required for admission to Langston University
 - two-page essay-style statement submitted with Nursing Application
 - TOEFL score of 550 on paper test, 213 on computer test or 80 on internet test is required for students who studied their secondary education outside the U.S.

Applicants must apply to Langston University Admissions Office *as well as* submit a separate application to the School of Nursing. A student may only be accepted to the nursing program if she/he has been accepted to the University. Both the School of Nursing and the Admissions office need a set of your official transcripts.

Step 1: Admission procedure for Langston University:

- Apply to Langston University at: www.langston.edu/apply-now Click on transfer application. After filling out the online application to Langston University, bring the nursing office at the UCSO your *official (closed envelope)* transcripts and immunization records. We will send them directly to Langston for admission to LU. You will also need to fill out the FAFSA for financial aid.
- You should receive an email after your application is processed stating you have been admitted or requesting any additional documentation. Admissions Office phone number is 405-466-3428.

Step 2: Admission procedure for School of Nursing:

- At the same time you apply to Langston University or afterwards, also submit an application to the School of Nursing by downloading and filling out the nursing application found at: www.langston.edu/school-nursing Click the “School of Nursing Application” towards the bottom of the page in orange letters.
- Include with your nursing application, a second set of official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended ***and*** a typed 2-page essay (stating why you want to be a BSN-prepared nurse and why you chose Langston University) along with your application. TOEFL score must be attached for international students. The instructions and further requirements are found on the application link above. Deliver your ***nursing application*** and supporting documents to the Langston Nursing office at UCSO in Ardmore for Ardmore Campus admission review.
